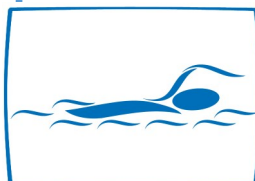

## SWIMMING NOTICE

It has been brought to our attention that many pupils are not wearing suitable swimwear for lessons. It is vital that lycra school swimming trunks, not shorts, be worn by pupils. This enables them not to be restricted when swimming or evacuating the pool. It also prevents unnecessary exposure which is uncomfortable for all present. Fitted lycra school swimming trunks enables the swimmers the freedom to move correctly in the water and evacuate safely. Children without the correct kit will not be permitted to enter the pool.
