FOCUS— YR1 & YR2

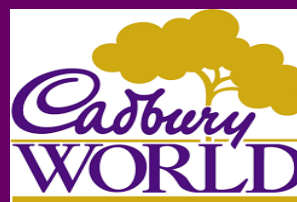
YR 1 have been creating their own animals and designing their own Zoo. They have had lots of fun! We also enjoyed French Day. We made our own French flag and learnt some new French words.
