You can choose how you present your work but please have a go at one of the following:

- Write a story about where you would go on dinosaur adventure, where would you go?
- Make a list of all the different types of dinosaurs you can discover.
- Imagine you were a dinosaur! Which one would you be and why? What could you hear, see, smell, taste and touch?
- Design, make or paint a dinosaur puppet or model.
- Research dinosaurs on the internet or at the library, what did they do in their habitats, where did they explore, where did they live?
- Dinosaurs had different body parts to us, can you draw and label any?
- Create a dinosaur mask or hat.
- Share stories or write a poem about dinosaurs with a grown up to help you.
- Do you have a toy dinosaur at home? Write a diary for him and tell us what they get up to.
- Visit a local tropical animal centre/shop/zoo and have closer look at some modern-day reptiles. Take some photographs to show us, do they look like dinosaurs?

## Parents:

- Especially over the holidays, please encourage your child to read as often as possible, listening to them whenever you can, as well as reading to them.
- Continue to practise spelling their tricky words.
- Encourage them to use their sounds to read or spot words they come across either at home or out and about.
- Reinforce our learning in Maths this term with numbers to 20 and 50. See if they can remember their 2D/3D shape learning, what shape is my slice of toast, a tomato etc.
- Continue their counting practise, I have 10 socks on the washing line and I need to hang 4 more up, how many is that?
