Projects

- Cook a dish using Autumnal fruit and vegetables.
- Go conker collecting and then thread them!
- Make a hedgehog home for your garden. Take photos or bring it in to show us.
- Make a collage of a woodland animal using natural materials.
- Go on a nature walk in the woods.
- Research a woodland animal and create a poster or leaflet to share the information.
- Make a celebration poster on Autumn festivals such as Bonfire night or Diwali.
- Anything else related to Autumn that interests your child!

Parents - how to help your child:

- Please encourage your child to attempt to write their name by themselves as often as possible.
- Ask your children to help you count how many you have, e.g. if I have 2 lollipops and you have 3, how many is that altogether?
- Ensure that your child enjoys their weekly library book.
- Practise reading and writing 3 letter words that have a vowel in the middle, e.g. cat, dog, mom, pan, cut
- Look for 2D shapes in the environment
