- Design an leaflet or poster about Fairtrade.
- Create a collage of different animals fur patterns using a range of materials
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It doesn't matter if it's not perfect - encourage them to have a go by themselves at first :)

Parents - how to help your child:

- Ensure that your child reads at home at least 3 times a week.
- Practice adding/subtracting and doubling to 20 using objects.
- Get them to verbally count past 20, can they make it all the way to 50 or 100?
- Encourage them to be writing proper sentences including finger spaces about anything that they like using their phonic fingers.
- If you would like any additional resources or support for your child then please do not hesitate to ask, it's what we're here for!
- Help them gain independence in skills such as tying laces or pouring drinks.
