
### **SPORTS 4 ALL FESTIVAL**

## AS A PARENT I AM KEEN TO BE INVOLVED IN THE LEARNING JOURNEY OF MY CHILD. HOW DO YOU ENABLE ME TO HAVE THESE OPPORTUNITIES?

**Open Afternoons:** This provides an opportunity for you to pop into school to look at the books and academic work produced by your child each term. It also provides your child the opportunity to explain their learning journey with you and demonstrate areas that they are proud of or areas of their learning that they may not be as confident in.

**Inspire Workshops:** Parental workshops focus upon a specific subject and engage the parents as well as the children to learn together in a safe environment whilst having fun.

**Productions/Poetry Recitals/Music concerts:** All our children have the opportunity to participate in a seasonal performance. Two or three classes work together to entertain our friends and families. Throughout this time your child will learn new songs, acting skills and be taught how to project their voice whilst speaking to an audience.

**Talent Show:** Our children are encouraged to work together with friends or alone to perform and demonstrate their hidden talents. The outdoor show is hosted by our school councillors and supported by staff. This is a relaxed fun event for our families and friends.

**Sports Day:** This is a great opportunity to encourage all pupils to be enthusiastic about sports and work as part of a team. Getting them actively involved in sports at a young age can make them healthier and happier.

**School Lunches:** We provide an opportunity for parents to sample our healthy menu at various times across the year. Our food is amazingly good value so these sessions are booked up swiftly.

**Family Fun Homework:** This provides a range of activities that you as a family can participate in at home. It provides the opportunity for your child and yourself to gain an understanding of what learning is coming up next.

Meal children.





### **HOW DO I USE PARENT PAY TO BOOK AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS?**

If you would like to book your child a place at our After School Club, please use the following steps to make your booking.

- Click on 'Book meals and places'.
- Click on the 'Make Bookings' drop down menu and select the club you wish to book (4.30pm or 5.30pm) and then click on the blue 'make or view bookings' tab.
- Click on the days of the week that you would like to book your child in for then scroll to the bottom of the page and click on the blue 'Confirm Bookings' tab. This will add the bookings to your basket so that you can pay for the club.

You will need to make sure that payment is made within 2 hours of the booking, otherwise the booking automatically cancels off the system.
