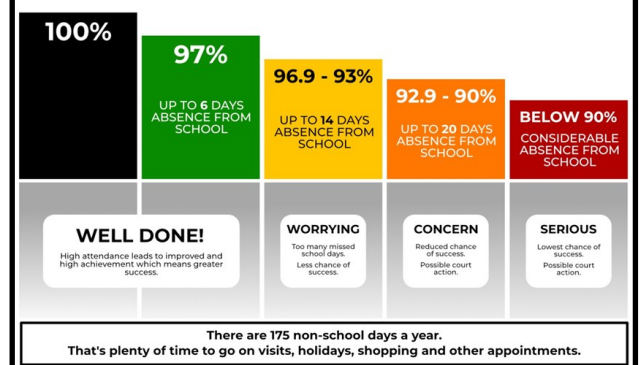
## SCHOOL START TIME
